Observation of the Commission –

- 1. Total people present in cell in 26 adult and 2 children, one male child aged about 4 years and one female child aged about 3 years. Both of their mother's are life convict, getting imprisonment.
- 2. Out of 26, 22 are life convict & 4 are under trial, there 3 are under trail of section 302 of IPC means charge of murder and one for section 498(A) of IPC.
- 3. For Child care & education, there has a semi English medium nursery school, run by KTC, Bishalgarh inside the jail complex, name "ANKUR NURSERY" Started on 17th July, 2018. Really it's a very good initiative. There has only one tutor in this school and pioneer is junior SCO.
- 4. There has facility of vocational training such as tailoring, wool knitting and flower bouquet making part of it.

- 5. For legal help, there has a legal aid clinic run by DALSA, here advocates are coming by rotation and 2 (two) nos. Of PLVs are there to provide legal assistance.
- 6. One lady Doctor General Physician, MBBS come here every day except Sunday. Female and Male both go to regular check-up, if require they shifted to Sepahijala District Hospital as well as AGMC or IGM whatsoever require.

Suggestion -

- 1. Extend Room numbers for women prisoners. Accommodate infrastructural development and make more rooms as they are living in very congested manner. Enhance more space.
- 2. There has no isolation cell in female ward. It's also necessary for special circumstances.
- 3. For mental health and prevent suicidal tendency or over all development. Kindly appoint a counselor to help them for mental peace or relaxation.

Jail Visit on 06.09.2018 Venue – Dharmanagar Jail, North Tripura.

Observation -

- 1. Total number of cell capacity is 4.
- 2. In one room, 8 female prisoners are staying.
- 3. One legal aid clinic, which is run by DLSA is situated within the jail premises for providing free legal aid to the female prisoners.
- 4. One General Physician, come every day except Sunday and provide medical help towards the female prisoners.

Recommendations -

- 1. Extend room numbers for women prisoners. Accommodate infrastructural development and make more rooms as they are living in very congested manner. Enhancement of more spaces in required.
- 2. For mental health and prevent suicidal tendency or over all development, kindly appoint a counselor to help them for mental peace or relaxation.
- 3. Appoint good lawyer for providing legal help. As a result of which, some genuine convict would get benefit out of it.

ACTIVITIES OF THE COMMISSION

In keeping with its mandate, the Tripura Commission for Women initiated various steps to protect the rights and interests of women and worked for their empowerment during the year under report. In the year 2018-19, the Commission has received a large number of complaints relating to various categories of crimes against women such as domestic violence, dowry torture, dowry death, kidnapping, desertion, bigamy, rape at promising marriage, sexual harassment of women at workplace, etc. Most of the cases registered in the Commission or brought before it relate to marital discord and domestic violence, the Commission took upon itself the task of counselling the parties concerned, so that family disputes could be settled speedily and effectively without being dragged into the Courts of Law. The Commission carried out its own investigations of the incidents of crimes against women like unnatural deaths or dowry deaths and incidents of rape reported to it or informed through paper clippings. Thereafter the Commission pursued those matters to expedite police actions. Apart from that, the Commission conducted many other inquiries into the cases relating to violations of women's rights either registered with it or suo-mote from paper clippings as and when considered necessary by the Commission. For taking proper action the reports of those enquiries were sent to the Police and to the concerned administrative authorities with the findings and recommendations of the Commission.

A Committee, comprising of Commission Members and Medical Officers of Government Hospitals, was formed with the aim of keeping vigilant watch on proper implementation of PC-PNDT Act in Government Hospitals and Private Nursing Homes in the State.

In different phases the Commission interacted with the print and electronic media, Medical Professionals, Administrative Officers,. Lawyers, Academicians, Social Activists and NGOs on the issues like increasing rate of crime against women and low conviction rate in women related crimes, implementation of different laws 'enacted time to time for protection and safeguard of women a.nd proper implementation of programmes and projects for development of women and during the period under report.

During the period the Commission visited Female Correction Centre, Destitute and Protective Homes for Women and Girls, Nursing Trainee Girls' Hostel, SC / ST Girls' Hostel attached to HS Schools of Tripura and Ladies Hostel for working women at Agartala. Recommendations for remedial measures to be adopted to improve the living conditions of the inmates were sent to the concerned authorities of the said Institutions.

The Commission gave top most priority on awareness generation programmes for the public in general and women in particular. During the year under report the Commission visited almost all Sub-Divisions under Districts including the remote areas of hills and plains of the State to reach the women and to make them aware about their rights.

A very special attention was given on Awareness Generation under 'Prevention of Crime against Women' in different places of Tripura in the period under report. The programme was conducted with the aim to aware people regarding care and protection of Women and Girl Child.

Apart from that, the Commission attended many seminars on women related issues like Women's Human Rights, Domestic Violence, Workshops on Laws affecting women including PC-PNDT Act and different Departments of the State Government, Government Degree Colleges, NSS Units under Plus Two Schools and Colleges. The Commission also attended various awareness generation programmes for public in general and for women in particular throughout the State organized by Panchayati Raj Institutions, different Departments of the Government, NGOs, Women's Organizations and local clubs during the period under report.

During the year under report the Commission maintained its networking with the National Commission for Women, the Women's Commissions for other States and attended meetings, seminars and workshops convened or organized by the NCW and the State Commissions.

During the year under 12 meetings of the Commission, presided over by the ,Chairperson, were held, where all important decisions regarding activities and new initiative of the Commission were taken.

Complaints received by the Commission during April 2018-March 2019.

Violence against women has been and still continues to be one of the wide ranging yet surprisingly under-recognized Human Rights violations. Taking into consideration the gravity and varying forms of abuse that women are being subjected to, it is apparent that acts of violence against women are not isolated events in a particular society or culture but are, in fact, a global phenomenon which circumvent socio economic structures and affecting all strata of our society. It manifests in various forms both within as well as outside the family. In Tripura, during the year under report, the scenario was found not very different from the trend prevailing throughout the country although some differences were also observed for the State In this respect. It was not that women were not safe and secured in Tripura and they could not move freely even in the night like many other States of our country. But, the overall commendable law and order situation of the State during the period under report did not match with the number of incidents of crime comnitted against women as reflected from complaints received by the Commission.

The complaints received by the Commission during the period under report relate to various categories of crimes against women such as bigamy, marital discord, domestic violence, atrocities for dowry, desertion, rape, Rape at Promising Marriage, bride killing, kidnapping/abduction, Sexual Harassment at Workplace and deprivation of different rights etc. The total rrumber of complaints received by he Commission from all parts of Tripura between April 2018 and March 2019 was 558. The Domestic Violence (family discord) remained as the largest category of crime committed against women in Tripura followed by dowry harassment during the period under report.

Accordingly to the Statement of complaints received by the Commission, crime rates are not uniformly high allover the State. The above mentioned table which gives the rates of crime against women in Tripura disaggregated at the District level, shows that there were considerable variations in the crime rates across the different districts of Tripura. Largest proportion of complaints relate to crimes against women was received from West District of Tripura followed by Sepahijala District during the period under report. Lowest proportion of complaints regarding atrocities against women was received from Khowai District during the year.

Accordingly to the Statement of complaints received by the Commission, crime rates are not uniformly high allover the State. The above mentioned table which gives the rates of crime against women in Tripura disaggregated at the District level, shows that there were considerable variations in the crime rates across the different districts of Tripura. Largest proportion of complaints relate to crimes against women was received from West District of Tripura followed by Sepahijala District during the period under report. Lowest proportion of complaints regarding atrocities against women was received from Khowai District during the year.

Out of the total number of complaints (558) received by the Commission regarding violence against women from places under different Police Stations (PS) of Tripura during the year under consideration, highest number of complaints was received from the areas under the Police Stations was lowest in Dhalai District (12).

Complaints relating to disputes with neighbours, crisis and distrust in different relationship claim for: 'compensation, fraudulent act etc. are categorized as miscellaneous cases. During the period under report number of complaints received by the Commission under miscellaneous category was 80.

By analysing the complaints received by the commission and by enquiring some of the complaints, it was observed that in some cases very trifling family or marital disputes were brought before the Commission, which could have been solved by themselves within the family.

Apart from that, as a result of massive awareness generation programme on legal rights of women organized by Tripura Commission for Women, State Legal Services Authority and some NGOs throughout the State, a large section of the women in Tripura were made courageous and aware about their rights and they, breaking all social barriers and stigmas, came out to lodge complaints with the Commission against any atrocities committed on them.

LIBRARY AND PUBLICATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

LIBRARY

The Tripura Commission for Women started purchasing books from its very inception for giving shape of a Library for the Commission. In the year 2010, a Librarian is appointed in the Commission and he is trying to set a full-fledged Library with its limited space and infrastructure. In the Year 2012 Library Rules has been introduced with a remarkable provision of lending books to out-sider library visitors like Research Scholars, Academicians, Students, Social-Activist and Book-Lovers etc. free of cost on deposition of their anyone of the original documents like voter 10 Card, PAN CARD, Driving License for the period of one week with option of renewal. In the same year "On Line Public Access Catalogue" (OPAC) system has been introduced through egranthalaya, with the kind cooperation & vital support of NIC.

At present the Commission has a collection of 3,767 books covering different subjects. This collection includes important reference books like Encyclopedias, Special Volumes on different disciplines etc. etc.

SUCCESS STORIES OF 2018-2019

F.3(6)-TCW/DV/01.11.2018

On 26.07.2018, one housewife from Amlapara under Khowai Jurisdiction, lodged written complaint against her Sister-in-law. The complainant informed that she stayed separately with her sister-in-law in one house. Family Dispute arised among Complainant and her sister-in-law after complainant's marriage. The opposite party falsely tried to establish an illicit relation among complainant and her brother-in-law and also passed filthy comments often. As a result of which the complainant tried to commit suicide twice.

On the basis of complaint, Commission called both the parties for counselling. The opposite party did not attend first counselling session but both the parties were present in second and third counselling session. In third counselling session, commission solved the matter on the basis of some conditions. The opposite party stayed separate along with her husban~ and children. In Follow-Up session, both the parties informed commission that they are living peacefully. Commission closed the matter as reconciled.

F.3(1)-TCW/DH/Sl.112/18

On 13.08.2018, one lady from Aamgaichhabari under Shidhai PSI lodged written complaint before commission. The complainant informed that during her ten years married life, often the opposite party tortured upon her mentally as well as physically. After knowing the financial condition of the complainant's parents house, the opposite party always forced her to bring money from her parental house. Under the effect of intoxication, the opposite party tortured upon the complainant. Even Mother-in-law also tortured upon the complainant.

In Counselling Session, the opposite party informed that the complainant maximum time tried to stay at her parental house. The opposite party admitted that sometime he took alcohol but denied and said that he did not torture upon the complainant.

Comission counselled both the parties. The complainant denied to lead a marital life but she wants maintenance. After some frequent counselling, commission solved the matter on the basis of some conditions. In counselling session it was decided that the opposite party will not to take alcohol further and also did not torture upon the complainant. The complainant maintained all the responsibilities of her family. In Follow-Up session, both the parties informed commission that they are living peacefully. The commission closed the case are reconciled.

F.3(1)-TCW/DV/Sl. 94/18

On 6.8.18, one lady from Chaanmari under west Ps, lodged written complaint against opposite party. In her complaint, complainant said that out of love and affair she married opposite party at temple. She also

said that after their marriage they stayed in a rented house and after that they shifted Kolkata and also stayed there for some days. But after some days the opposite started torture upon her. The parents of the opposite party went to Kolkata and returned back along with their son i.e opposite party. After that the opposite party did not make any contact with the complainant.

In counselling session, the opposite party said that they were living as husband and wife for some days. The opposite party returned to agartala due to his mother's illness. Presently the opposite party did not want to continue a conjugal life with the complainant.

Commission Counselled both the parties. The complainant demanded for compensation. After long counselling it was decided with the consent of both the parties that the Opposite Party will give Rs 4,00,000/ (Four Lakhs) to the complainant at a time. As per the decision, on 25.9.18, the opposite party in presence of the Member of the commission, handover the cheque of Rs.4,00,000/ (Four lakhs) to the complainant.

F.3(3)-TCW/Kidnapped/Sl.38/19

On 5.5.18, one lady from Piyarichara under Kadamtala PS, filed written complaint before commission. In her complaint, she said that a boy from upthakhali under Panisagar Ps, forcefully kidnapped her daughter from dharmanagar on 3.5.19. The complainant tried lot to rescue her daughter but failed to rescue. The complainant informed commission regarding the matter. After receiving the information, women commission's chairperson Smt Barnali Goswami reached to that spot where the boy kept the kidnapped girl. When the chairperson reached to that spot, the local people and the family members of the boy gave objection, but avoiding all situation, taking risk of her life, chairperson Smt Barnali Goswami rescued the girl from one closed room. Police came to that spot after receiving the information and controlled the situation. Chairperson with the help of the police handover the girl to her parents. Victim girl also gave statement regarding the statement.

F.3(2).TCW/Maint/Sl.02/19

On 29.1.19, one lady from Kalikapur under West Ps, lodged written complaint before commission claiming compensation from her husband i.e opposite party. Commission counselled both the parties frequently for solving the matter. The opposite party agreed to give compensation. The complainant also demanded for divorce. In counselling session, with the consent of the parties, it was decided that the opposite party gave Rs 9,50,000/ to his wife and children as compensation but in two instalment. The opposite party deposited the money before the commission. After getting the decree of mutual divorce, the complainant received the total amount of Rs. 9,50,000/ from the commission.

SUCCESS STORIES OF 2019-2020

F3(1)TCW/DV/SL 301/19

On 21.10.18, a Complainant lodged a complaint against her husband at TCW. She informed that they got married 3 & ½ years back and since that her husband regularly tortured her physically and mentally under the effect of intoxication. Both parties have been asked for counseling at TCW. During counseling session Respondent told that he torture her wife due to her bad behavior. After long counseling session commission mitigated the matter. Now they are living together peacefully.

F3(1)TCW/Misc/SL 26/19

On 16.05.19 under Dasda Police station, a man lodged a complaint that his minor daughter was missing while going from Dharmanagar to Dasda on same day. Simultaneously Complainant informed the matter to TCW. After receiving the complaint, without making any delay Chairperson, TCW, investigated the matter. On 16.05.2019, at 10.30pm, the Chairperson, TCW, went out for searching that minor girl. At first Chairperson paid her visit to the rented house of that minor girl. After reaching there she met with the friend of such minor girl and after conversation, Chairperson, TCW, came to know that the minor girl had a regular conversation with her boyfriend. Chairperson, TCW, collected the number of that boy from minor girl's friend and talked with that boy. After a long searching, the Chairperson, with the help of police rescued the minor girl from Laalchara and handover the girl to her parents.

F3(1)TCW/Adultry/SL 18/2019

On 4.11.2019, Complainant lodged a complaint against Respondent for adultery, at TCW. In her complaint, it is informed that Respondent stay out of station due to his job. He did not give any maintenance and also denied to take responsibilities of his wife and children. In counseling session respondent denied the allegations, given by complainant, but agreed that he did not maintain her wife and children. After long counseling session, on the basis of some conditions, commission mitigated the matter. As per the decision of the commission the respondent agreed to deposit Rs. 15000/- per month in the SB Account of Complainant. Also it was decided by the commission that the Respondent during his leave period, will stay at his own house with his wife and children. The respondent also promised that he will not do any work which bring trouble for the complainant. The Complainant informed later on to the commission that now they are living peacefully.

F3(1)TCW/Property/SL 354/2019

According to law, to get the paternal assets a lady under Sreenagar P.S, lodged a complaint at TCW against her brother. Accordingly TCW, requested both the parties for counseling. In counseling session, the complainant demand to get her full paternal assets. Respondent also agreed to do so. Then it has been decided in presence of complainant, respondent and local panchayet member, the respondent will hand over the assets to the complainant which she entitle and as per the decision of the commission, the respondent will hand over the assets within one month from the date of the decision. Later on the complainant informed the commission through written application that she got her all assets back from the respondent.

Overview of Complaints Registered in the Commission From Divided Districts of Tripura during April 2019-March 2020.
